DIRECTIONS TO GE AEROSPACE, Cheltenham

From The West

M5 to junction 11, A40 towards Cheltenham and follow signs to Swindon Village and Bishops Cleeve.

From Swindon

A419/A417 Cirencester bypass to Cheltenham (East). Head for Cheltenham Town Centre and then follow signs for Evesham (A435) and Bishop's Cleeve.

From London

M40/A40 to Cheltenham. Follow signs for Evesham (A435) and Bishop's Cleeve.


From The North

M5 to junction 10, A4019n towards Cheltenham and follow signs for Bishop's Cleeve.

Public Transport

Trains to Cheltenham (Landsdown) Station. Bus to Royal Well bus station and then by bus to GE Aerospace, Bishop's Cleeve.

General Information

Getting Onto Site – Your instructor will meet you every morning at a pre-agreed time at the main reception, where you will get your passes and then be escorted onto the campus. (You will be notified of the time to start on your first morning via CTEC U or email, prior to the commencement of your course).

Student Passes - Wear your student pass (always administered to you on your arrival at reception on your first day) while on GE Aerospace property. The pass allows you to travel unescorted to the kitchen, restrooms, and back to your classroom. You must have a GE escort if you wish to travel to other areas of the building or site. Return your badge and its plastic holder to your instructor at the end of each day who will then escort you off the site and then meet you again the following morning at the main reception.

Cameras – No photography of any kind is permitted anywhere on the GE Aerospace site.

Food services – Tea, coffee & water are available throughout your working day and is free of charge. There is a cafeteria where you can purchase lunch and other snacks. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the premises of any GE Aerospace facility.

Mail - Your personal mail should be sent to the hotel/motel of residence during your training period.

Currency exchange – All currency exchange should be done prior to your arrival at GE Aerospace. Airports and banks will be able to accommodate any currency exchanges.

Medical services – Ensure you have checked what kind of medical insurance you will need while in the UK and have taken the necessary steps prior to arrival.

Please inform your instructor if you need medical attention during class or if you are ill and cannot attend a class.

Parking - Free parking is available at GE Aerospace if you drive to class. You will need a car pass from main reception.

Passports/Visas – It's advisable to bring your passport with you everyday to GE, as this can be used as identification when obtaining your pass.
